We read the newspaper and listen to the news. It is very clear that we face serious challenges as a society -- as serious in their own way as those we faced in World War II. We believe President Obama when he says we need a new "era of responsibility," and that it needs to start with people in every community in the country. As Obama put it: We need to "remake this nation the only way it's been done in America for two-hundred and twenty-one years -- block by block, brick by brick, calloused hand by calloused hand." What are our challenges?

- More than 1 in 5 Hispanics and 1 in 3 blacks are expected to be living below the poverty line by 2010.
- Global warming is likely to lead to major flooding, devastation of farmland, and extreme poverty in parts of the developing world; the U.S. will not be spared from its effects.
- Experts at Harvard predict that there is a 50% chance of nuclear terrorism in the next 10 years on American soil.
